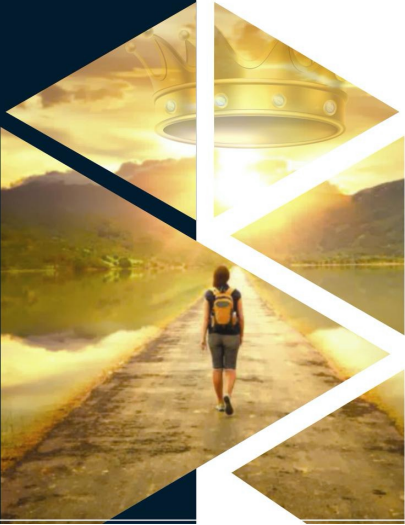

# OVERVIEW



## 1. Our Journey to Freedom is a live-long journey!

- Jesus explained that **HE had come to FREE us**, but the Pharisees claimed that they were already FREE, because they were descendants of Abraham!

*“But we’re the descendants of Abraham and we’re already free. We’ve never been in bondage to anyone. How could you say that we will be released into more freedom?”*

*John 8:33 TPT*

- a) The Jews did not forget about their slavery in Egypt, but they were in fact saying that they were not **in bondage to serve anyone, because they were free sons of Abraham.** Jesus reminded them that their ancestral lineage did not guarantee spiritual freedom.
- b) **“Release into more freedom”** is translated in Aramaic as **“released as children of freedom.”**

## 2. Freedom comes from Jesus, and is not the result of any ancestral lineage!

*“To this day we are aware of the universal agony and groaning of creation, as if it were in the contractions of labor for childbirth.” Romans 8:22 TPT*

*“And it’s not just creation. We who have already experienced the firstfruits of the Spirit also inwardly groan as we passionately long to experience our full status as God’s sons and daughters—including our physical bodies being transformed.” Romans 8:23 TPT*

## 3. Even creation longs for Freedom!

- “All creation longs for FREEDOM from its slavery to decay and to experience with us the wonderful FREEDOM coming to God’s children.” Romans 8:21 TPT

*“For this is the hope of our **salvation**. But hope means that we must trust and wait for what is still unseen. For why would we need to hope for something we already have?”*

*Romans 8:24 TPT*

*“So, because our hope is set on what is yet to be seen, we **patiently keep on waiting** for its fulfillment.” Romans 8:25 TPT*



## 4. Full Salvation!

- “All creation longs for FREEDOM from its slavery to decay and to experience with us the wonderful **FREEDOM coming to God’s children.**” Romans 8:21 TPT

*“For you are reaping the harvest of your faith—the full salvation promised you—your souls victory”! 1 Peter 1:9 TPT*

- a) This is our FULL SALVATION - the salvation of the spirit, soul and body!
- b) All our miseries in life are birth pains towards our full status as SONS and DAUGHTERS of Adonai.
- c) Our final FREEDOM comes, when we will receive our glorified bodies. On that day we will cry out: “O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?” 1 Corinthians 15:55 NKJV

## 5. Set free from our former Master!

- In the past we were servants of sin. “If you choose to love sin, it will become your master and will reward you with death.”  
Romans 6:16 TPT

*“And now you celebrate your FREEDOM from your former master – sin! You’ve left its bondage, and now God’s perfect righteousness holds power over you as his loving servants.”*

*Romans 6:18 TPT*

- a) Paul clearly indicates that we have a choice to leave our bondage and walk out in **FREEDOM!**
- b) Doing wrong has left us in shame and death (Romans 6:21). “But now, as God’s loving servants, **we live in joyous freedom from the power of sin.**” Romans 6:22 TPT
- c) “So, consider the benefits you now enjoy – you are brought deeper into the experience of **true holiness**, that ends with eternal life!” Romans 6:22 TPT

## 6. Finally, a Way Out!

- Paul discovered that the way to FREEDOM, is by a renewed mind!

*“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, in order to prove by you what is that good and pleasing and perfect will of God.”*

*Romans 12:2 MKJV*

When a person gets wounded multiple times, while growing up, demonic spirits have legal right to **speak deception and lies** to that person’s mind. The thoughts remind him of all the injustices that were done to him, so that the person develops anger, hatred and bitterness in his heart towards the people who wronged him. Once he starts to **agree with the demonic thoughts**, he gives legal right to even more thoughts and desires of vengeance, which can consume him. Our minds thus need to be transformed!





## 6. Finally, a Way Out!

- A renewed mind can only come through our union with Jesus!

*“I give all my thanks to God, for his mighty power has finally provided a way out through our Lord Jesus, the Anointed One! So if left to myself, the flesh is aligned with the law of sin, but now my renewed mind is fixed on and submitted to God’s righteous principles.”*

*Romans 7:25 TPT*

When we get married, while still in a wounded state, we will project all our pain and wounds from the past onto our spouses. We will control and manipulate them and will pridefully and selfishly demand that they do what we want.

**Wounded people live in denial.** Denial is the fog that darkens our thinking. It focuses our thoughts and desires inwardly to our own selfish needs and desires!

## 7. Freedom comes by the “spirit of acceptance”!

- When Jesus leads you out of Bondage into FREEDOM, you no longer live under the "spirit of religious duty", leading you back into the fear of never being good enough. You have received now the "**spirit of acceptance**," enfolding you into the family of God.

*“<sup>15</sup> For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, **Abba, Father.**”*

*Romans 8:14-15 KJV*

- a) When you are in bondage, your mind constantly tells you that you are NOT GOOD ENOUGH. Harboring these thoughts mean that you accommodate the orphan spirit!
- b) But, when Jesus sets you FREE, you will walk in the spirit of acceptance.
- c) We all become sons and daughters of adoption and can cry out: “ABBA FATHER!”, that is Daddy!

## 8. Freedom, at last!

- “Let me be clear, the Anointed One (Jesus) has set us free—not partially, but completely and wonderfully free!” Galatians 5:1 TPT

*At last we have freedom, for Christ has set us free!*

*“We must always cherish this truth and firmly refuse to go back into the bondage of our past”.*

*Galatians 5:1 TPT*

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- a) No one else, **BUT JESUS**, can set you **FREE!**
  - b) He is the **GOD**, who claimed: “*I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage*”. [Exodus 20:2; Deuteronomy 5:6]
  - c) Don’t you dare give glory to anyone else or to any ministry, that helped deliver you!
  - d) The challenge is not to be healed or delivered, **BUT** to stay clean and **FREE** afterwards!
  - e) Therefore, refuse to go back into the bondage of your past!

## 9. YOUR JOURNEY – THE POINT OF DEPARTURE

- In these days, Satan works in ways hard to believe, even though it be told to you!

*“Look, you mockers, and marvel, and perish and vanish away;*

*For I am doing a work in your days,*

*A work which you will never believe, even if someone describes it to you [telling you about it in detail].” Acts 13:41 AMP*

- a) Paul quoted scripture from Habakkuk 1.
- b) He referred to the works of the Chaldeans - “speaking of demonic forces”.
- c) These forces possess dwelling places that are not theirs. They contaminate your mind and cloud your thoughts!

**“For, lo, I raise up the Chaldeans, that bitter and hasty nation, which shall march through the breadth of the land, to possess the dwelling places that are not theirs.” Habakkuk 1:6**
